Flags from Around the World*

Directions: Flags are often used as ways to demonstrate something you believe in, such as the flags for a country, or a flag associated with a sports team. Below are examples of flags from countries around the world. Point out the details in each of the examples and make a connection between the images used and the mottos and how they demonstrate the value. To get started, you will each identify three values that are important to you, such as truth, justice, and forgiveness. Then, you'll each design a flag to illustrate your values.



The motto on the flag translates as: Strength United is Honor.

Angilla



The white represents peace, the blue symbolizes the sea, faith, youth, and hope; the three dolphins stand for endurance, unity, and strength.

Zimbabwe



The bird, star, and white triangle represents peace, green is for agriculture, red is for the blood shed for independence, black is for the color of the people.

Ecuador



The yellow color represents sunshine, grain, and mineral wealth. Blue symbolizes the sky, sea, and rivers, and red the blood of patriots spilled in the struggle for freedom and justice.

Honduras



The stars represent the countries in Central America, the blue symbolizes the Pacific Ocean and the Caribbean Sea, the white band represents the land between the two bodies of water, peace, and prosperity.

Thailand

The red color symbolizes the nation and the blood of life, white represents religion and purity, and blue stands for the monarchy.
