




- Trust and Honesty- If your boss or co-workers don't feel they can trust you to be on time, do the tasks you have been assigned and in general follow the company expectations, you most likely won't be working there very long.
- Respect Each person has a role to play at work. Each has responsibilities. Has anyone heard the phrase, "there is no 'I' in team?" At work, often one person's tasks are contingent upon another person's responsibilities. Respect also makes room for valuing each other's input, encouraging a collaborative atmosphere.
- Being Self-aware Taking responsibility for what you say and do and the attitude that you bring to the workplace. Nobody likes a mopey grumbler.
- Communication Letting others know what and where you are at with assigned tasks, in all forms of communication like texting, email, social media methods of communication, phone calls, video calls etc. Remember! Not everyone communicates the same way and to ensure a good working relationship, you have to meet people where they're at. If your boss likes to send long emails, that means you've got to check your email and respond in a timely manner in the same method.














DIVE IN

Pro Tip



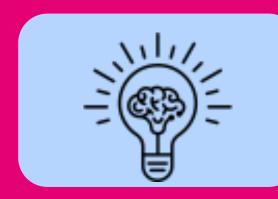

I'm excited to share that your student has been learning about essential workplace skills in class. We discussed the importance of trust and honesty as the foundation of any relationship, especially in the workplace. 
