# Emozi Student Leadership Toolkit – High School (Grades 9–12)

## Purpose

Prepare students for post-secondary life by building leadership through SCOPE-IT and connecting Emozi skills to college, work, and community roles.

## Leadership Roles

- **Peer Facilitators:** Lead group discussions using SCOPE-IT (Stop–Consider–Options–Plan–Evaluate–Insights–Transform).
- **Ambassadors:** Represent Emozi at school board/community events.
- **Mentors:** Partner with 9th graders or middle school students to model SCOPE-IT.
- **Event Coordinators:** Help plan and emcee Emozi Nights or school-wide assemblies.

## Activities

- **SCOPE-IT Circles:** Student leaders facilitate peer circles where classmates problem-solve real dilemmas.
- **Future-Ready Panels:** Students share how Emozi skills apply to job interviews, applications, or stress management.
- **Recognition Program:** Lead a “Caught with Character” initiative to spotlight peers demonstrating Emozi.

## Adult Support

- Train student leaders in facilitation and confidentiality.
