



Emozi Student Leadership Toolkit – Middle School (Grades 6–8)

Purpose

Help adolescents build leadership by practicing SCOPE and supporting peers through real-life situations.

Leadership Roles

- **Advisory Leaders:** Guide short check-ins using SCOPE (Stop–Consider–Options–Plan–Evaluate).
- **Peer Mentors:** Support younger students (elementary “buddies”) in learning Emozi skills.
- **Discussion Starters:** Kick off class discussions with a question: *“What options could we consider here?”*
- **Event Helpers:** Co-lead at Emozi parent/student nights.

Activities

- **SCOPE Shout-Outs:** Students nominate peers who used SCOPE during the week.
- **Student-Led Skits:** Act out peer scenarios and demonstrate decision-making with SCOPE.
- **Journal Sharing:** Volunteer readers reflect on how SCOPE helped them in school or friendships.

Adult Support

- Give leaders clear scripts and checklists.



- Rotate roles so many students experience leadership.
- Highlight leaders during school announcements or newsletters.
