- HALT, HOOT, HEART Strategy:
 - HALT: Pause and recognize emotions
 - HOOT: Take calming breaths
 - HEART: Reflect and respond constructively
- Body Budget Awareness: Emphasizing sleep, hydration, nutrition, and exercise
- Expanding Emotional Vocabulary: Teaching a range of feeling words

Module 4: Lesson Implementation and Classroom Integration

- Using stories, songs, and crafts for emotional learning
- Role-playing activities for empathy and conflict resolution
- Structured lesson walkthrough:
 1. Story introduction
 2. Song activity
 3. Interactive learning tasks
 4. Home Connection Letter
