- Guide students in recognizing their emotional triggers and using strategies to regulate their responses.
- 5. Strengthen Decision-Making Skills
  - Help students evaluate the consequences of their actions to make safe and ethical choices.
  - Teach students to reflect on their decisions and grow from mistakes.
